Addressing Sexual Dysfunction in CPT and PE

Target Audience: Clinicians in the field working with adults who have anxiety, trauma, and sexual difficulties

Instructional Level: Introductory

Course Description: Presented by Jordan Soper, PsyD, ABPP, CST, the purpose of this course is to focus on the interconnection between PTSD and sexual functioning concerns. Many trauma survivors experience difficulties including loss of interest/desire, avoidance, intrusive thoughts during sexual encounters, and communication barriers. The presentation will identify common variables associated with sexual functioning and PTSD, identify interventions to be integrated into trauma-focused treatments (i.e., CPT & PE), and provide resources for recovery.

1. Participants will be able to identify the diagnostic criteria of Sexual Dysfunctions according to the DSM-5
2. Participants will be familiar with diversity concerns often impacting sexual health and functioning
